Welcome to term 2 of the year and to 2024! We have another busy time ahead in the next few weeks. Next week, we will be visiting the Manchester Synagogue and Museum, which links to our next unit in RE, this will be such an exciting and enriching opportunity for Y6. The children will also continue to volunteer their time at St Nathaniel's Food Pantry, which is our class cause for the year and is now well underway. Money Mentors will continue into this term, which continues to make Y6 aware of money management. We also now have our WOW ambassadors in place. English

This term in English, our unit focus will be a story called Who Let The Gods Out by Maz Evans, followed by Cold Heart of Summer by Alan Gibbons.

We are reading... Our class read this term will be Who let the Gods Out by Maz Evans. An exciting tale of the arrival of a zodiac Goddess into the real world, unleashing the demons of myth into reality.

We will also be reading Athena: The Story of A Goddess by Imogen Greenburg, in keeping with our Greek theme.

Maths

In maths this term we will be starting with units of measurements and then continuing to develop of fractions knowledge by applying this to decimals and percentages.

We will also deepen our understanding of area, perimeter and volume.

Time is of the essence, please continue to ask your child the time on an analogue clock as well as digital.

Science

This term we will be focusing on the physics unit of earth's movement.

We will then be moving onto the chemistry unit of materials, before finishing the term with the biology unit of living things and their habitats.

History

This term in History, we are continuing to explore Ancient Greece through the concepts of artefacts and society but also through culture and past times.

We will then move onto The Aztecs, focusing on the concepts of beliefs, conflict, settlement and food and farming.

Geography

This term in geography we will continue to advance our understanding of the earth's biomes, looking at the types of biomes and climate zones and their locations around the world, with a specific focus on the Americas.

We will then move onto learning about ocean currents.

Homework

Homework will be given out each **Friday** and should be returned by the following **Thursday**. Homework will always be linked to something we are doing in class.

Home Reading

Please listen to your child read at least **three** times per week for at least 15 minutes and record it in their diary. Diaries must be signed by an adult after each read and need to be in school each **Monday** to be checked by Mr Yorke.

Other curriculum information

Skills Builder- The two skills we will be focusing on this term are Teamwork and Problem Solving.

Art and Design- This term we will be focusing on architecture, looking at the work of Zaha Hadid.

Computing – Throughout the year we will complete online safety lessons. Alongside that, this term we will be exploring the Python coding system.

PSHE – We will discuss challenging discrimination. We will also have a Money Mentors session.

PE – spring term, children will partake in dance, gymnastics and hockey.

RE – During the first half term, we will be looking at what is important in Jewish life and worship before moving onto a topic in understanding who Jesus was.

Music – This term in music we will be exploring dynamics, pitch and texture.

Spanish –After a successful first 2 units on fruit and vegetables, we will be learning all about presenting ourselves and discussing our families.
